Fermented and aged in the bottle: flavour comes from the time on lees

Summer grown rice, brewed in the cold of winter with yeast, kōji mould and water. Softer than wine, harmonious with food

Sakes are listed in order of body and flavor: from light to rich

Honjōzō: fragrant sake

Made lighter and more fragrant by addition of brewers' alcohol

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Junmai: pure rice sake

Full bodied, with rice character
